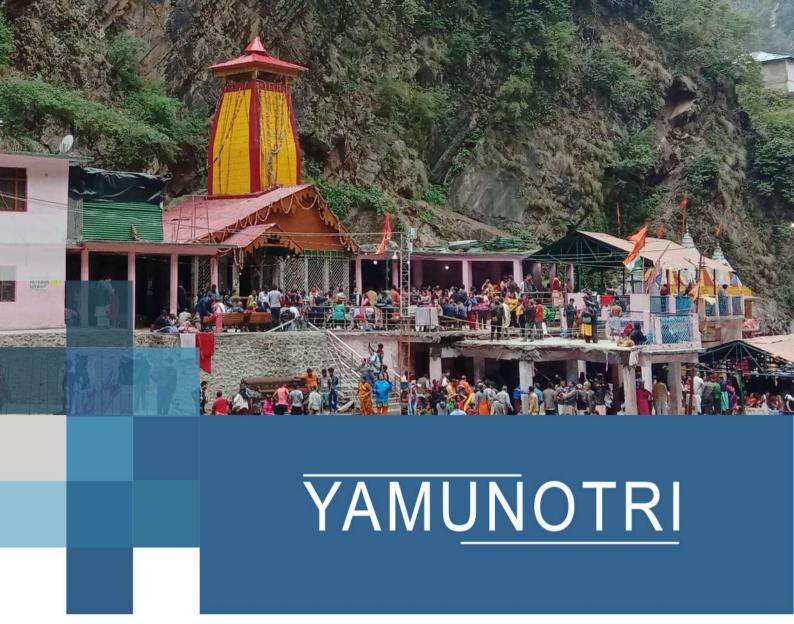






INTRODUCTION

The Chardham of Garhwal refers to the four ancient temples the mark the spiritual sources of four sacred rivers, the Yamuna [Yamunotri], the Ganga [Gangotri] the Mandakini [Kedarnath] and the Alaknanda [Badrinath]. Every year during the yatra [pilgrimage] season from April to November, hundreds of thousands of dedicated Hindu pilgrims makes the important treks the exact dates that the temples are open are announced each year by local priests.



INTRODUCTION

Yamunotri Temple nestles in a valley close to the source of Yamuna. Hinduism's second most- scared river after the Ganges. For piligrams Yamunotri is the least visited and so least developed of the Chardham temples, but once you get to the trailhead it's an easy trek in. The Treks begins where the road ends at Jankichatti, 7Kms beyond the village of Hanumanchatti [2400m]. There are hot springs and 1 Km away is a pretty village Kharsali. From here it's a 5 Kms, two -hour trek of Yamunotri temple [3185 m]. Hight mountain close in around the temple and there are several hot springs where you can take a dip, and others where piligrams cook potatoes & rice as Prasad.



GANGOTRI

INTRODUCTION

In a grand remote setting at an attitude of 3042m, Gangotri temple was originally constructed by Gorkha commander Amar Singh Thapa in 18th century. The brave and devout take a dip in freezing flow of an embryonic Ganga river. Nearby is the rock on which Shiva is said to have received the Ganga in his matted locks. As the source of the Ganges [known as the Bhagirathi until it reaches Deoprayag] Gangotri is the one of the holiest places in India.





KEDARNATH

(INTRODUCTION)

Kedarnath is revered as the source of the Mandakini River, but the magnificent temple is primarily dedicated to the hump that Shiva [who had taken the form of bull] left behind when he dove into the ground to escape the Pandavas. Other the portion of Shiva's body are worshipped at the other four Panch Kedar Shrines, which are hard to reach but can be visited: the arms at Tungnath the face at Rudranath: the navel at Madmaheshwar: and the hair at Kalpehwar. The actual source of the Mandakini River is 12Kms past Kedarnath. The temple was originally in the 8th century built by Adiguru Shankaracharya, who is buried behind the shrine. The surrounding scenery is superb, but Kedarnath attracts 100,000 pilgrims every year, which mean plenty of people, nose and litter. The site is so suspicious the pilgrims used to throw themselves from one of the cliffs behind the temple in the hope of instantly attending moksha [liberation].



INTRODUCTION)

Basking in a superb setting in the shadow of snow – topped Nilkantha, Badrinath temple appears almost lost in the tatty village that surrounds it. Sacred to Lord Vishnu, this vividly painted temple is the most easily accessible and most popular of the Chardham temples. It was founded by Guru Shankara in the 8th century but the current structure is much more recent. Below the temple are hot springs that reach a scalding 40 degree C and serve as laundry for locals.

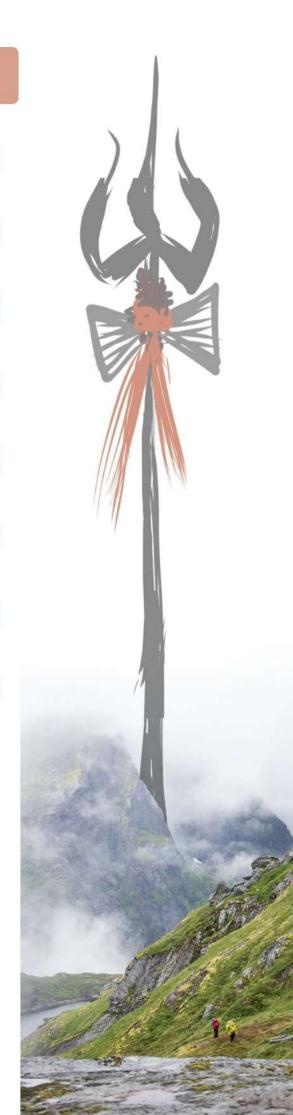

Delhi Arrival

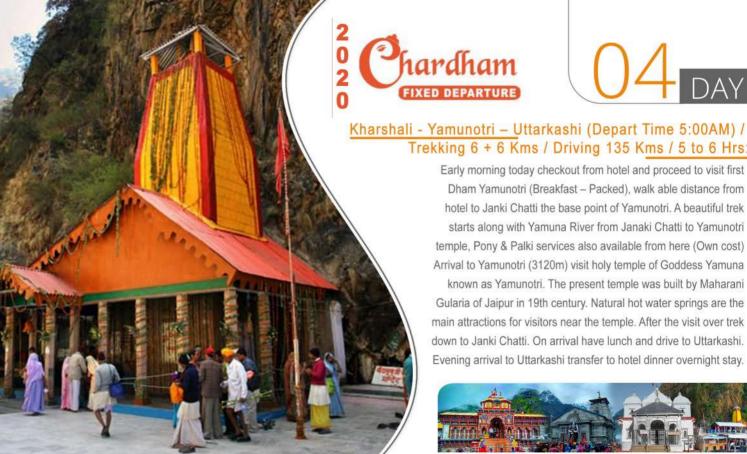
On arrival to Delhi Airport & Railway Station you will assist by our representative after meet and greet proceed to hotel. On arrival check in to hotel rest of the day free for Leisure. Dinner overnight stay in Delhi.











Trekking 6 + 6 Kms / Driving 135 Kms / 5 to 6 Hrs: Early morning today checkout from hotel and proceed to visit first Dham Yamunotri (Breakfast - Packed), walk able distance from hotel to Janki Chatti the base point of Yamunotri. A beautiful trek starts along with Yamuna River from Janaki Chatti to Yamunotri temple, Pony & Palki services also available from here (Own cost) Arrival to Yamunotri (3120m) visit holy temple of Goddess Yamuna known as Yamunotri. The present temple was built by Maharani Gularia of Jaipur in 19th century. Natural hot water springs are the main attractions for visitors near the temple. After the visit over trek down to Janki Chatti. On arrival have lunch and drive to Uttarkashi. Evening arrival to Uttarkashi transfer to hotel dinner overnight stay.



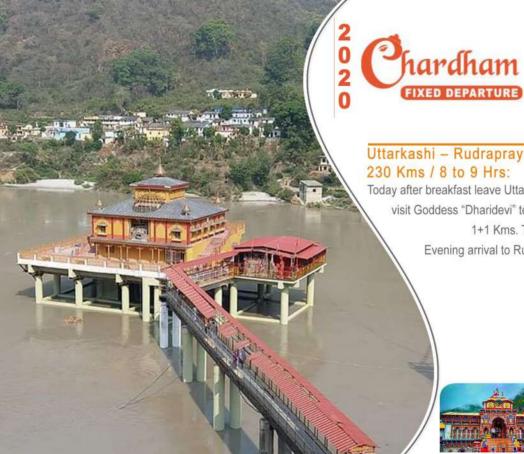


Uttarkashi - Gangotri - Uttarkashi / (Depart Time 7:00 AM)
Round trip 200 Kms / 10 to 11 Hrs:

After early breakfast today proceed to visit the second Dham "Gangotri" along with Bhagirathi river the Journey of Gangotri becomes a wonderful journey. Beautiful valleys, Small rivers, waterfalls Local villages' worth to visit over here. On arrival to Gangotri Temple (3050m) visit the holy temple of Goddess Ganga, pooja / darshan. The present temple of Gangotri was built in 18th century by Gurkha commander Amar Singh Thapa. After lunch return journey to Uttarkashi on arrival darshan Kashi Vishwanath temple. Dinner overnight stay.





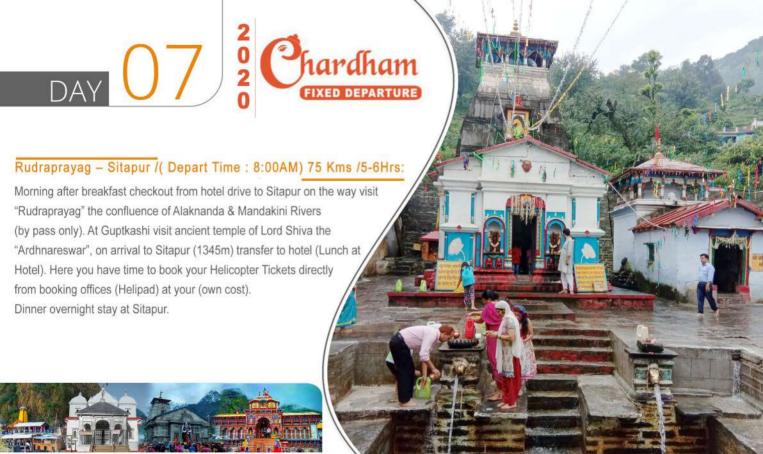


06 DAY

Uttarkashi – Rudraprayag / (Depart Time 8:00AM) 230 Kms / 8 to 9 Hrs:

Today after breakfast leave Uttarkashi and proceed to Rudraprayag, En route visit Goddess "Dharidevi" temple near Garhwal Srinagar, trek up & down 1+1 Kms. Taxi services also available at your (own cost) Evening arrival to Rudraprayag check in to hotel, dinner overnight stay







08 DAY

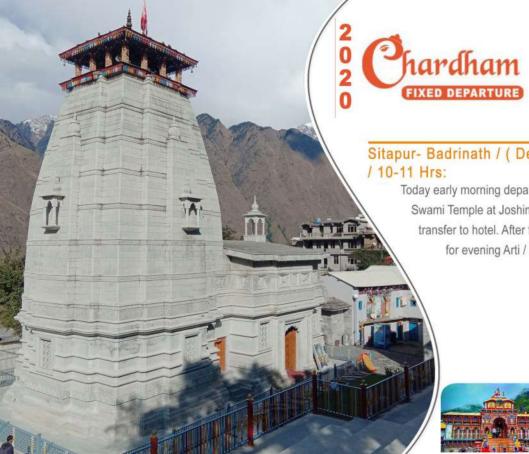
Sitapur –Sonprayag – Gaurikund - Kedarnath / (Depart Time 4: 00AM) One side Trek 16 Kms / 6-7 Hrs:

Today early in the morning checkout from hotel and proceed to Sonprayag the reservation - counter & base point for Kedarnath journey (walk able distance from hotel / 1Kms only). After booking Pony & Palki from here next drive to Gaurikund by local taxies the shuttles service Own cost 5 Kms) visit Kedarnath Temple(3585m)

A beautiful trek of 16 Kms leads towards holy temple along with Mandakini River. Trek is very hard & stiff there are many climbing to reaching Kedarnath Temple. On arrival to Kedarnath check into hotel (Dharamshala),after freshen up Evening Alankar & Aarti / Darshan of Kedarnath ji Overnight stay





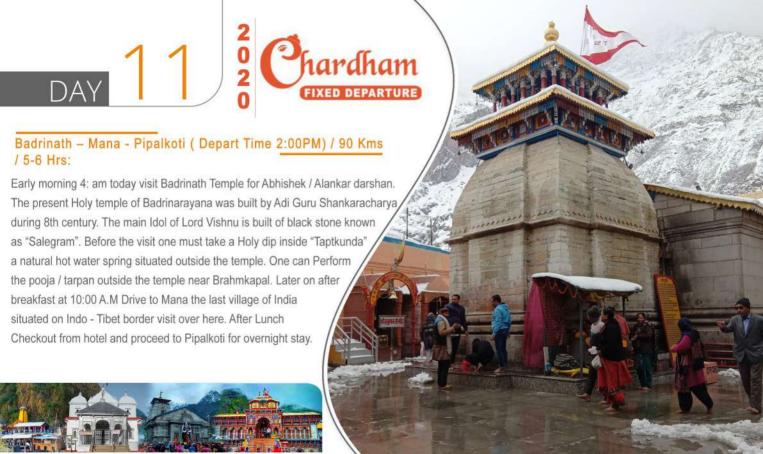


10 DAY

Sitapur- Badrinath / (Depart Time 5:00 AM) /250 km

Today early morning depart to Badrinath Dham, en route visit Narsingh Swami Temple at Joshimath. In evening arrival to Badrinath (3400m) transfer to hotel. After freshen up proceed to visit Badrinath Temple for evening Arti / Darshan. Dinner Overnight stay at Badrinath

Do's

- Ensure you are physically and mentally fit to perform the journey as the Yatra involves trekking at an altitude of 14,000 ft. Get yourself medically examined and certified fit for the journey.
- Kindly carry some dry eatables like glucose, candies, lemons etc. with you
- When asking for directions, speak to shopkeepers, not pedestrians. Check with at least two
 persons or more. Do not go out alone during late evenings and night. Always move in groups.
- If you are carrying Digital Camera or Handy cam, do carry extra pair of battery, as there is no guarantee if there is electricity for charging you equipment
- Carry a small torch. It is essential equipment as lights can go off at any time. Always carry a raincoat and an umbrella during your travel
- Carry personal toilet items, they are very useful during the breaks in long journey of Char Dham
- Do carry enough woollens clothes including sweaters, thermal body warmers, trousers, monkey caps, mufflers, wind cheaters, raincoats, sleeping bags, blankets, waterproof shoes with sufficient grips, torch with sufficient batteries and walking sticks
- Kindly carry Hugging clothes like pants & Jeans, for Ladies it is recommended to avoid wearing sarees [use pants, Suit & Salwar Kamiz]
- · Ensure that your luggage is waterproof

Don'ts

- Do not take bath or clean your articles at Ghats.
- Do not take pictures if cameras are not allowed in any area and temples.
- Do not throw wrappers on road or in the forest trek during journey
- · Alcohol is strictly prohibited
- Do not carry heavy jewellery & expensive items during journey
- Don't eat too much food on your journey
- Don't use slippers & sandals, only wear trekking/ sport shoes







Travel Tips

Weather Conditions:

1) Your journey shall involve trekking across high mountains, facing strong cold winds. You must carry adequate woolen clothing; (ii) a small umbrella; (iii) Winchester; (iv) raincoat; (v) waterproof trekking shoes; (vi) torch (vii) walking stick; (viii) cap (preferably a monkey cap; (ix) gloves; (x) jacket; (xi) woolen socks; (xii) trousers (preferably a waterproof pair). These items are essential as the climate is highly unpredictable and changes abruptly from sunny weather to rain and snow. The temperature can sometimes abruptly fall to 5 degree Celsius or lower.

2) Id proofs

Government issued identity proofs need to be shown at Biometric Registration, mostly Aadhar Card the hotel or resort before check-in. Always keep the ld proof with yourself while travelling. Keep a digital copy of your documents in your mobile devices in case of loss or emergency. (Pan Card won't be acceptable)

3) Medicine

Keep all necessary medicine along with you required any time during the journey.

(4) Safety Tips

- 1) Maintain distance with tourist guides, bus conductors, taxi drivers and local guides if you find them pressuring you to take their assistance. Don't be rude, but decline their offers politely,
- 2) Do not go out alone during late evenings and night. Always move in groups.
- 3) Make a note of emergency numbers and details of the hotel where you are put in.
- 4) Avoid taking eatables offered by the local people in buses, taxis etc.
- 5) Make sure all your expensive stuffs are kept in safety lockers of your hotel room. Carry just enough money. During your travel, keep your cameras and other devices safely in a bad and check regularly.
- 6) Maintain a separate pouch to keep liquid cash handy. In case you are carrying more money or withdrew it from ATM, do not expose it in the public place
- 7) Do not trust strangers.
